

Mold, Lead, and Pests

Mold, lead, and pests are common problems inside buildings.

If NYCHA doesn't do regular maintenance to get rid of them, they can make you and your family very sick.











Mold, Lead, and Pests

It's really important to hold NYCHA accountable for making sure you have a healthy home!

It's not something you have to tackle alone!



Mold



Mold can grow anywhere there is moisture, like where there are leaks, under sinks, or in bathrooms that don't have good airflow.


Signs of mold in your home:

Feeling sick or experiencing breathing issues without cold symptoms

 Mold spores, clusters of black, brown, or green dots, or a musty or damp smell

You may not see it if it's growing under a surface or behind a wall

Lead



Lead is a poison that can't be seen or smelled, but can be found in paint on the walls or ceilings, or your drinking water.

Signs of lead in your home:

- You can't tell if your home has lead in it just by looking at it! You have to get it tested by NYCHA to find out
- Lead testing is especially important if you have a young child in your home

Pests



Common pests include mice and rats, roaches, bedbugs, and other insects. Pests are attracted to food, trash, and moisture.

Signs of pests in your home:

- Droppings, bites, or dead pests
- Chewed up food packages

Health Effects

Mold Makes allergies and asthma worse, and causes other breathing problems Can cause chronic headaches, fever, nausea and vomiting, and sore throats Especially dangerous for children, the elderly, and people who are sick

Mold Lead Makes allergies and asthma Causes developmental problems and learning worse, and causes other difficulties in children breathing problems Can cause chronic headaches, Causes behavioral, nervous fever, nausea and vomiting, system, heart, and muscle and sore throats problems in children and adults Especially dangerous for children, the elderly, OW! and people who are sick

Health Effects

What You Can Do About It

Mold Check moist areas of your house for mold Make sure your apartment has good ventilation Clean mold on hard surfaces and replace soft surfaces like carpet

What You Can Do About It

Mold Lead Check moist areas of your Get your apartment tested house for mold by NYCHA, especially if you have young children Make sure your apartment has good ventilation Clean mold on hard surfaces and replace soft surfaces like carpet

What You Can Do About It

Mold Lead **Pests** Check moist areas of your Get your apartment tested Keep garbage in sealed bags house for mold by NYCHA, especially if you or containers and remove it have young children from your home every day Make sure your apartment has good ventilation Store food in sealed containers Clean mold on hard surfaces and replace soft surfaces like carpet

But NYCHA is responsible for making sure you have a healthy home, and removing mold, lead, and pests, as well as the things that are causing them.

This is the law!

Hold NYCHA Accountable



- Put a ticket in to NYCHA about your mold, lead, or pest issues
- If you have young children, make sure NYCHA knows, so that they'll respond faster
- Keep a record of your conversations
- Demand full repairs
- When they test your apartment, ask them the exact level of lead






